

Accreditation Denotes Excellence



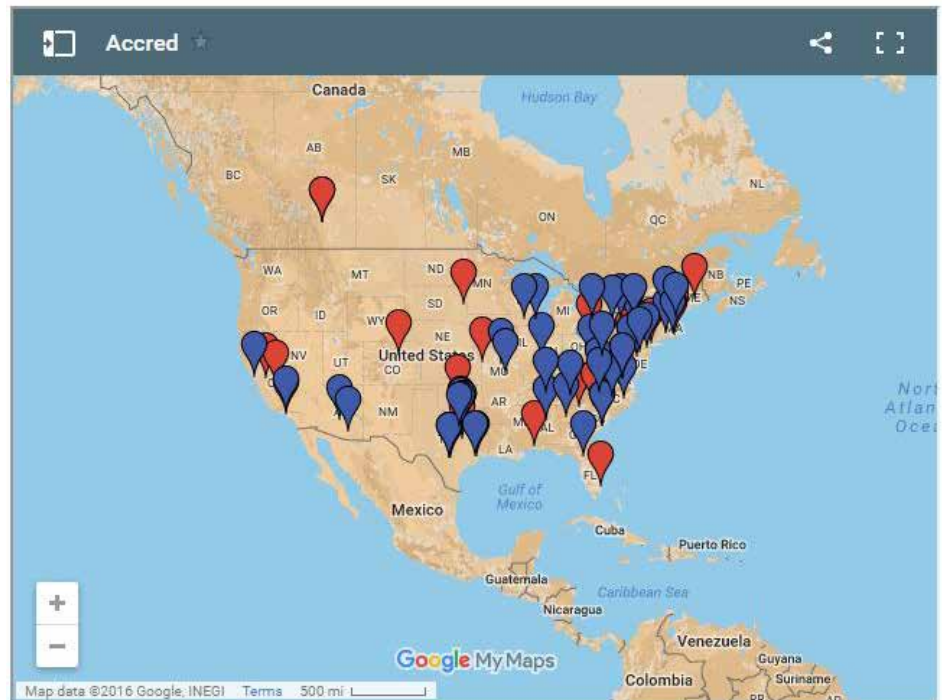
