2017 IACLEA Annual Awards Nominations

Nominations will be accepted until March 17, 2017

Each year IACLEA recognizes outstanding contributions by its members to the campus law enforcement profession with the presentation of the following awards: **Award for Valor**, **Award for Merit**, **Award for Administrative Excellence**, and **Award for Innovations in Community Oriented Policing**. Please consider nominating a colleague for these awards. Eligible nominees include employees of IACLEA member campus law enforcement agencies. The **Officer Memorial** has been established to honor a campus public safety officer killed in the line of duty.

Each award winner receives a commemorative gift and is recognized at the awards ceremony, which takes place during the Annual Conference. The winner's photograph and details of the award are published in the *Campus Law Enforcement Journal* and are posted on the IACLEA Web site. IACLEA pays for two nights' hotel and transportation expenses for one person to attend the awards ceremony.

Award for Valor

This award is presented for an act or acts involving personal risk while acting on behalf of the college/university/campus or members of the college/university/campus.

Award for Merit

This award will be presented to the campus officer who each day displays professionalism and excellence in performing his/her duties or whose actions and attitude bring credit to the campus law enforcement community.

Award for Administrative Excellence

This award is presented for outstanding service in areas such as policy and planning, investigations, and/or crime prevention. New and innovative ideas, cost savings, enhanced administrative techniques, and management ideas are some of the elements that will be considered for award selection.

Award for Innovations in Community Oriented Policing

This award will be presented to an employee of an IACLEA institutional member campus public safety, police, or security department for outstanding service and initiative supporting the effective promotion of the Community Oriented Policing philosophy. New and innovative ideas, demonstrated significant impact of an evidenced-based crime prevention program or initiative, and development of strong community partnerships programs are some of the elements that will be considered for award selection.

Officer Memorial

This award is presented posthumously to honor a campus public safety officer killed in the line of duty.
